- Bus stops in yellow are the limits you can go freely with one-day pass.
- Pink lines indicate walk-ways to "Sites of Japan's Meiji Industrial Revolution" or Other tourist spots.
- UNDO KOEMMAE You can also get off and get on at UNDOKOEMMAE with one-day pass besides bus stops within ones in yellow.
- You cannot get off and get on at any stops between TOMACHI/NIHOMMATSUGUCHI and UNDOKOEMMAE.
